Rainbow Playschool

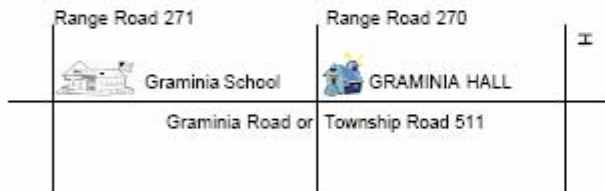
